

USDA Extends Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) Deadlines for 2021-2022 School Year

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has extended CEP deadlines for the 2021-2022 school year through a <u>nationwide waiver</u> that gives states and school districts more time to consider community eligibility. The waiver makes the following adjustments to annual CEP deadlines:

CEP Requirement	Annual Deadline	Waiver Deadline
Data Used to Calculate ISP	April 1	Anytime between July 1, 2020 and June 30, 2021
LEA Notification	April 15	June 30, 2021
State Agency Notification	April 15	June 30, 2021
State Agency Publication	May 1	June 30, 2021
Elect CEP for SY 2021-2022	June 30	September 30, 2021

<u>CEP</u> offers districts and schools the opportunity to provide free breakfast and lunch to all students. As schools continue to respond to dramatic spikes in childhood hunger driven by the pandemic, CEP can provide the tools they need to reduce hunger, improve nutrition, and support academic success.
